The new campus transforms one of Lombardy's leading healthcare complexes, embracing the complexity of the context as a design resource. The project recognises the historic and urban value of the Spedali Civili and reinterprets it in a contemporary key, with the aim of building a more legible, accessible and integrated system.

The project works on **three complementary levels**: continuity with the architectural memory of the existing hospital, the functional reorganisation of clinical and logistical routes, and the definition of a new public landscape able to connect care, university, research and urban life.

The **One Health** principle guides the entire design. Individual health is understood as part of a wider system, in which the quality of spaces, environmental comfort, accessibility, greenery, sustainable mobility and the relationship with the community all contribute to building a new model of healthcare infrastructure.

The project is organised into **two main buildings**. The **Main Hospital** reinterprets the radial logic of the historic hospital through three interconnected wings, open towards the city and oriented to the landscape of the Brescia foothills. On the ground floor, a continuous glazed lobby defines the urban threshold of the project, opening onto a new public square and making the hospital a permeable, recognisable and accessible place.



The internal organisation favours clear layout, intuitive orientation, natural light and environmental comfort. The principles of **Healing Architecture** are translated into measurable design choices: control of light quality, acoustic comfort, calibrated proportions and views towards the landscape. Each room is conceived as a space of decompression, in which the visual relationship with the outside becomes an integral part of the care experience.

The **Children Hospital** is conceived as an autonomous, protected organism made up of three cylindrical volumes of different heights. Terraces and internal courtyards, like a therapeutic garden, will bring nature into direct contact with the wards, while the entrance lobby, organised around a large full-height atrium, will house play areas and consultation spaces in a bright, protected setting.

The central element of the project is the **CareRing**: a continuous ring of over one kilometre that organises mobility, logistics and public life. More than a simple infrastructure, the CareRing is a landscape device that connects the campus to the city, separating technical and operational flows underground from clinical routes and unfolding at surface level as a continuous green system.



Landscape, movement and hospital functions thus converge in a single spatial figure, an expression of the One Health principle and of the idea that human health is inseparable from environmental quality.

The new complex is conceived as **an open system**, able to evolve over time together with medical technologies, organisational models and the needs of contemporary healthcare. The hybrid timber-and-steel structure, dry-assembled, helps reduce the carbon footprint, optimise construction times and ensure the modularity of spaces for possible future reconfigurations.

The **digital dimension** runs through the project as an integrated infrastructure: smart wayfinding systems, flow management, environmental monitoring and support for the use of spaces improve efficiency, accessibility and safety without overriding architectural quality.

The building envelope actively contributes to the building's environmental performance. The façades integrate solar-control strategies, energy optimisation and visual continuity, balancing internal comfort, natural light and the relationship with the landscape.

ISMETT 2 is the new highly **specialised hospital** in Carini (Palermo), an expansion of ISMETT in Palermo and **a reference transplant centre for the Mediterranean**. It is part of an **integrated care-and-research system**, alongside the Centre for Biotechnology and Biomedical Research, on a site of about 16 hectares.

The building has an **H-shaped plan**, symmetrical about the entrance lobby, and rests on a base blended into the greenery. On the ground floor it opens to the city with a **public outpatient area**: a **wayfinding** system and the separation of flows - patients, visitors, vehicles, logistics - translate complexity into clear routes. Extensive **green roofs**, with a landscape and therapeutic role, complete the relationship with nature.

Conceived as **an efficient infrastructure open to technological evolution**, it integrates provision for AGVs, vertical silos and pneumatic transport, a mixed structure of concrete, precast elements and steel, and prefabricated systems for façades, bathrooms and stairs. With **250 beds** and developed in **BIM**, the project sees **Politecnica**, as part of a consortium, handle the review of the Developed Design, the Technical-Economic Feasibility Study and the Detailed Design based on the concept by **Renzo Piano Building Workshop** with Progetto CMR.

The **New Hospital of Cremona** stands on the boundary between town and countryside, where the dense network of **Lombard farmsteads** becomes the matrix of the design: two **open-courtyard buildings**, one facing the countryside, the other the town, with a rotated wing generating the entrance square. A system of bridges converges on the **central Showcase**, a full-height green void and the public heart of the hospital. The client is ASST di Cremona; the facility has **445 beds**.

The hospital and **Health Park** are conceived as a single healing environment. The park, laid out as woodland with the Clearing as a green amphitheatre, offers spaces for sport, ecosystem, education and community; inside, patios and therapeutic gardens bring light and nature into the wards, which are naturally lit for over 90% of daylight hours.

Conceived as **a flexible organism**, it adopts an 8×8 m structural grid and a 2 m façade module that allow spaces to be reconfigured and single rooms to be turned into doubles. Logistics are automated — AGVs, RGVs, pneumatic mail and vertical silos — for hygiene and efficiency.

The building is **NZEB**: heat pumps, photovoltaics, reuse of rainwater and greywater, and a design that **reduces the carbon footprint by 65%** compared with a standard hospital (stages A1–A3, LCA).

The **New Padua East Hospital Complex**, in the San Lazzaro district, is a **highly specialised hub** of national and cross-regional importance, set to become one of Italy's leading healthcare complexes. On a site of about **40 hectares** and over **200.000 sqm** of built area, it brings together **963 beds** - of which 90 in intensive care - together with research and teaching functions and 58 primary departments.

The complex is organised into **four building blocks**: a Day Center for outpatient activities, a high-intensity-care podium with emergency department and operating block, a Ward Tower and a Research Tower. Facilities include **40 operating theatres**, 280 outpatient clinics and 12.000 sqm of laboratories.

Conceived as **Italy's first post-pandemic hospital**, it integrates multimodal accessibility - a new tram line, heliport and vertiport - and a **fully automated logistics system**: vertical silos, pneumatic transport, AGVs, RGVs and PTS. The building is **nZEB**, with on-site photovoltaic generation and a strong relationship between care spaces, greenery and landscape.

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The **new Livorno City Hospital** arises from the redevelopment of the former Pirelli site and part of Parco Pertini, in continuity with the Spedali Riuniti. Not a healthcare enclave but a **“piece of city”**, permeable, with services open to the public and a close relationship with greenery and the neighbourhood. The client is Azienda USL Toscana Nord Ovest.

With about **88.500 sqm** and **488 beds** - of which 344 high-care and 40% in single rooms - the hospital is developed on a **three-level base podium**, topped by a two-storey ward block. The structure is organised into **four areas** - Emergency, Surgical, Medical-Oncological and Maternal-and-Child - to optimise routes and share staff and equipment.

The project adopts the principles of **healing architecture**: a green roof mantle, terraces with healing gardens, natural light in the intensive-care units and spaces for staff wellbeing. Sustainability relies on 7.000 sqm of photovoltaics, recycled materials, rainwater harvesting and soft mobility.

The **Città della Salute e della Scienza in Novara** replaces the current Ospedale Maggiore della Carità with a new complex integrating **clinical care, university teaching and research**, serving a catchment of over **400.000 residents** and on an urban area now derelict, returned to public use.

With over **200.000 sqm** of built area and **711 beds**, the complex brings together the hospital, a maternal-and-child area, a university building with lecture rooms and laboratories, administration, a multi-storey car park and a nursery. Compared with the brief, the project proposes a **more compact and efficient configuration**, with optimised volumes, streamlined internal flows and reduced building impact.

Developed in a **BIM environment** with a **fast-track** methodology, it integrates automated logistics, advanced environmental control and the separation of technical routes from clinical ones. The approach is **person-centred**: bright interiors, green areas visible from the wards and intuitive routes, attentive to the comfort of patients, caregivers and staff.

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The **Zealand University Hospital in Køge**, south of Copenhagen, is the extension and reconstruction of the existing hospital for **Region Zealand**. The project transforms it into a **university hub for the biomedical sciences**, set to become the largest hospital in the region and one of the largest in Northern Europe.

The project integrates the existing facility with **114.000 sqm** of additional space, bringing capacity to **789 beds** and concentrating wards, emergency services and research functions in a single complex. The most demanding aspect was delivering it **while keeping the hospital fully operational** throughout the construction works, with tight planning and coordination between designers, contractors and healthcare staff.

Central to the project is the use of **prefabrication**: precast reinforced-concrete floor beams and a modular-panel façade, compliant with the European Building Class 2020 requirements. The building is **integrated into the landscape** with a planting scheme of native species and courtyards and themed routes conceived as spaces of care.

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The **New Galliera Hospital** renews, in the hillside district of Carignano, a historic, highly specialised Genoese facility founded in 1877. On a complex, protected site overlooking the sea, the project replaces the no-longer-efficient pavilions with new volumes concentrating the key departments - from the Emergency Department to the operating block, from diagnostics to the wards - for a total of **404 beds**. The client is the Ente Ospedaliero Ospedali Galliera.

The concept is that of a **green hospital within the city**: a partly underground clinical podium, with basement parking, is topped by three ward blocks that appear to float above **roof gardens**. These green roofs mitigate the heat-island effect and become urban parks open to the public too, mending the relationship between hospital and neighbourhood.

The ward volumes, arranged as a **quintuple-bay block**, are protected by vertical white fibre-cement brise-soleil that ensure privacy, shading and open views, in keeping with the protected monumental building.

The complex has a **net floor area of 70.230 sqm** over eight levels, for a works value of about **122 million euros**. The design was carried out entirely in **BIM**, also for management and maintenance purposes.

Opened in December 2024, the **New Hospital of Pordenone** is the main healthcare facility of Western Friuli. Built for the Azienda Sanitaria Friuli Occidentale (AS FO), it brings together in a single complex all the functions for treating acute conditions, from the Emergency Department to the operating block and the wards, with **475 beds**.

The architecture, understated yet iconic, stems from the idea of **urban integration**: a horizontal base harmonises in height, colour and permeability with the surrounding fabric, reinterpreting the arcade typical of Pordenone, while the ward blocks rise above. The **green internal courtyards** and the greened roofs bring in natural light and improve insulation and environmental quality.

Conceived according to the principles of **Lean Healthcare**, it clearly separates the flows of patients, staff and visitors and adopts a modular, seismic-resistant layout that can be quickly reconfigured. The building services integrate trigeneration, heat pumps, photovoltaic and solar-thermal systems and a dual network for water reuse.

The complex has a **gross floor area of 82.500 sqm** over seven above-ground floors, for a works value of **276 million euros**. The design, carried out entirely in **BIM**, produced the Digital Twin for predictive maintenance.

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The **New Hospital of La Spezia** occupies a panoramic position above the city, among olive groves and a historic garden, overlooking the Gulf of Poets. Designed for a **Level II Emergency Department**, it brings together in a single complex the activities of the existing Felettino, Sant'Andrea and San Bartolomeo facilities, serving as a point of reference for Liguria and neighbouring regions. For the client IRE S.p.A. it provides **506 beds** (of which 34 in intensive care) and **12 operating theatres**.

The building is organised into **four fan-shaped building blocks**, connected by a central spine that generates three large courtyards. The geometry follows the slope of the terrain and opens most of the façades to the south, towards the city and the sea; the courtyards host **roof gardens** and a strip of protected greenery set out as parkland.

Conceived for **flexibility**, it adopts a quintuple-bay module on a 7,5×7,5 m structural grid, with double-pendulum seismic isolators, a ventilated terracotta façade and prefabricated elements for façades and bathrooms.

The complex has a **floor area of over 66.000 sqm** over seven above-ground floors. The building services integrate a **trigeneration system**, rooftop photovoltaics and BMS supervision; the entire design was carried out in **BIM**.
